Dr. Vaishampayan Memorial Government Medical College, Solapur, affiliated to the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik, Maharashtra vide its letter No.VMGMC/PG/MCI LOP-Recognition/4727-30/2022 dated 26<sup>th</sup> April, 2022 had applied for **recognition against increased intake of one (4 to 5) seat** of MD (**Anesthesiology**) qualification in respect of students being trained at the medical college, having an annual intake capacity of **seven seats** in the said course.

2. WHEREAS, the Post-Graduate Medical Education Board (PGMEB) got the assessment of the **Dr. Vaishampayan Memorial Government Medical College, Solapur** done on **30<sup>th</sup> January, 2023** for verification of infrastructure, clinical material, faculty for all-round training of students as per curriculum requirement. On scrutiny of the Assessment Report and other records, the Post-Graduate Medical Education Board (PGMEB) found the following deficiencies:

- Deficiency of three Associate Professors as per MSR -2020;
- OPD work load in the entire hospital was inadequate; and
- The Surgical workload was also inadequate.

3. WHEREAS, the deficiencies stated in **para 2 above** were pointed out to the said medical college vide PGMEB Letter No.35/46(156)/2022-PGMEB/010523 dated 7<sup>th</sup> March, 2023 and the medical college was given an opportunity to submit a written explanation in respect of the deficiencies. The said medical college furnished the reply vide Letter No.VMGMC/PG/MCI Insp-Anesthesiology/193/2023 dated 6<sup>th</sup> April, 2023. The Compliance Verification Report and the report of the Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System (AEBAS) of the **Department of Anaesthesiology** for the period 01.09.20203 to 18.12.2023 (copy enclosed) were placed before the Post-Graduate Medical Education Board. The Board found that though the faculty and Senior Residents are registered on AEBAS, however, many of the faculty and Senior Residents were not available on 50 per cent of the working days for at least four hours per day during the aforesaid period. Further, some of the faculty/SRs are not marking attendance regularly. Thus, the Board has concluded that there is deficiency of the faculty and Senior Residents in the Department; and the faculty and Senior Residents posted are not complying with the AEBAS guidelines issued by NMC from time to

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time. Hence, the reply furnished by the medical college was not found satisfactory and acceptable by the Board.

4. WHEREAS, the responsibility of determination and maintenance of standards of post-graduate medical education is entrusted upon the Post-Graduate Medical Education Board of the National Medical Commission as per National Medical Commission Act, 2019 (NMC Act, 2019) and Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations, 2023 (MSMER-2023). As per **A.1.15** of **Schedule-I** of the Minimum Requirements for Annual M.B.B.S. Admissions Regulations, 2020, and **A.3.1** and **3.2** of the **Schedule-I** of the UG-MSR-2023, installation of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System (AEBAS) is mandatory and NMC has been advising the medical colleges/institutes to install the Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System (AEBAS) from time to time. With a view to effectively implement the AEBAS, NMC *vide* its letter No.D-130024/07/2022/NMC/DMMP dated 1st August, 2022 issued instructions to all medical colleges/institutions to install AEBAS devices for biometric attendance. Further, **Section 8(1) and (2)** of the MSMER-2023, stipulate imposition of penalty(ies) on the medical college/institution, if they fail to comply with any statutory provisions.

5. WHEREAS the medical college has failed to comply with the requirements and has compromised with the quality of medical education. **Considering the non-implementation of the AEBAS guidelines and deficiency of faculty and Senior Residents in the Department of Anaesthesiology, which is not adequate to train the post-graduate students studying in the medical college, the Post-Graduate Medical Education Board has decided to approve six seats of MD (Anesthesiology); and to reduce the annual intake capacity in the course of MD (Anesthesiology) from the existing seven to six seats for the Academic Year 2024-2025.** Hence, the break-up of **MD (Anesthesiology)** seats in the medical college will be as indicated below:



However, the students admitted by the medical college till the Academic Year 2023-2024 will not be affected by this reduction of seats and their post-graduate degrees will be considered recognised for the purpose of registration of the degree awarded by the University.

6. WHEREAS, the medical college is free to prefer an appeal before the National Medical Commission under Section 35(5) of the National Medical Commission Act, 2019 and Section 9 of Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations, 2023, within sixty days from the date of issuance of this letter in accordance with NMC

Sir,

This is to inform that the Board of Governors considered the matter with regard to conversion of Diploma Seats into corresponding Degree seats from the academic year 2020-21 along with the request of the institute received through Central Govt. after notification dated 12/07/2018 as well as the recommendations of the PG Expert Group (BoG) on the basis of information furnished by the institute(s) as desired by the Council and decided to recommend to the Central Government for conversion of the postgraduate diploma course seats into corresponding degree seats prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2020-2021. (As per the list attached)


The permission to convert postgraduate diploma seat(s) to degree seats is subject to affiliation of additional PG degree seats by the concerned University.

The Institutes are required to obtain the affiliation from the concerned affiliating University with regard to above enhanced intake capacity of the degree courses before admitting the students.

In view of above, you are requested to issue Notification/ letter recognizing the above mentioned degree seats for the purpose of inclusion in the first schedule of the IMC Act, 1956 as is done in respect of recognition cases against increase of degree seats.

The Ministry is further requested that while issuing the Notification/ letter of recognition as stated above, it may be clearly stated that the said recognition was granted to degree seats created by way of surrender and conversion of diploma seats, so that the confusion as regard to timeline of recognition of degree seats is avoided.
